INSTRUCTIONAL TIPS

a usually says ā at the end of a syllable (rule 4).

a may say ah at the end of a syllable.

SOUNDS/SAMPLE WORDS

INSTRUCTIONAL TIPS

o usually says ō at the end of a syllable (rule 4).

o may say ō (most) when followed by two consonants (rule 19).

SOUNDS/SAMPLE WORDS

INSTRUCTIONAL TIPS

i usually says ĭ (rule 5).

i may say ī at the end of a syllable (rule 5).

i may say ī (find) when followed by two consonants (rule 19).

SOUNDS/SAMPLE WORDS

(Sound each separately)

y

y yet

ǐ gym

ī my

INSTRUCTIONAL TIPS

The consonant sound y is used only at the beginning of a syllable, usually the first one.

y usually says ĭ, but may say ī (my) at the end of a syllable (rule 5).

y, not i, is used at the end of English words (rule 6).
